

**CITY OF BANE BERRY
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION
Meeting Minutes: August 7, 2017
7:00 p.m.**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Baneberry Parks and Recreation Commission was held on August 7, 2017, at the Baneberry City Hall. Meeting was called to order by Mark Davis, Chairman.

Members present: Mark Davis, Chair; Clare Davis, Secretary; Bucky Miller, Wendy Krempels, Brenda Slot, Nancy Broughton, Commissioner, Donna Hernandez, and guest, Judy Keane.

Minutes: A motion was made by Bucky Miller to accept the minutes of June 6, 2017, and seconded by Wendy Krempels. Motion passed. (Note: There was no July, 2017 meeting due to holiday.)

OLD BUSINESS

Fourth of July Wrap-up:

It was noted that the suggestion for the ice cream cups was a great idea and will be continued for future 4th of July events. A question was asked if it had been determined how many carts were in the parade, however, no specific count was kept.

Mark Davis read a suggestion from resident, Carolyn Metzger. Carolyn suggested that next year we increase the number of golf cart prizes as follows: 1 prize for originality, one for most funny, and one for patriotic. She also suggested that five (5) bicycle prizes be awarded in order to spike more kid involvement. Members agreed to consider this for next year's planning.

Wendy Krempels suggested that T-Shirts be made for Parks and Rec Members to help designate the members for special events. Donna Hernandez and Wendy Krempels will research cost and design for these shirts and report back at next meeting.

Surveys: Bucky Miller reported on survey responses. Suggestions include: pot lucks, Pizza Night, Christmas Market. Judy Keane made suggestion to have a White Elephant Sale similar to a silent auction. This suggestion was discussed and it was determined that plans would be considered for a pot luck dinner in February to include a Silent Auction and the proceeds would be donated to a local charity. Charities discussed included the Humane Society or the Boys and Girls Club.

Christmas Market: Dolly Harmon has expressed interest in continuing the Christmas Market which was such a success last year. Members discussed holding the Market at the Community Center vs. the Baneberry Golf Course. Donna Hernandez will contact Pat Hardy with the State to determine the feasibility of profit making by vendors. Also discussed was whether to include

only Baneberry residents as vendors or allow vendors from outside to participate. Ads could be purchased in local papers to advertise this event.

Decorations for Fall: It was decided that again this year, the front of City Hall will be decorated. Members will meet on September 23, 2017 at 10 a.m. to decorate.

NEW BUSINESS:

Nancy Broughton indicated that she would like to propose an Open Garden Tour of residents who have flower gardens. She will look into this and report back to the members.

A motion was made by Wendy Krempels to adjourn the meeting.
